Official Rules

Game Overview

In this trivia game, you always compete against real opponents. Skill and speed determine your success. Play smart and you can win big!

Answer a set of questions as quickly and accurately as possible. The more correct answers you give and the faster you respond, the higher your score. **The game lasts 2 minutes.**

Scoring Basics

- Correct answers earn points.
- Faster answers earn additional speed bonuses.
- Wrong answers may result in point deductions.
- Remaining time after all questions is added as a bonus.

Question Types

1. Multiple Choice

- Each question has **4 possible answers**.
- You have **up to 20 seconds** to select the correct one.
- **Scoring:**
 - **+2,000 points** for each correct answer
 - **Speed bonus:** +1 point per 20 milli seconds remaining of the first 15 seconds
 - **Speed Penalty:** -1 point per 20 milli seconds after the first 15 seconds.
 - **-150 points** for each incorrect answer
- Jokers (Power-Ups)
 - Each joker can be used once per game and does not cost any penalty points.
 - **Refuse to Answer:**
 - Skip the current question without answering it.
 - Score: 0 points
 - No point deduction
 - **50/50 Joker**
 - Removes 2 incorrect answers, leaving only 2 possible choices.

2. True or False

- You will receive **4 statements (one at a time)**, each with **2 possible answers**.
- You have **5 seconds** to answer each statement.
- **Scoring:**
 - **+500 points** for each correct answer
 - Minus **+1 point for every 10 milliseconds** used
 - **-10 points** for each incorrect answer
 - **-10 points** if time runs out before an answer is given

3. Timeline

- You are given a topic and one item to start with.
- Additional items will appear one at a time. Drag and drop each new item in its correct position relative to the item(s) already shown.
- You have **10 seconds** to place the item.
- **Scoring:**
 - **+500 points** for each item placed at the correct position
 - **Speed bonus:** +1 point per 10 milli seconds remaining of 10 seconds
 - **-150 points** for each incorrect answer

Fair Competition

All players in the same contest receive questions from the **same subject area** and with a **comparable level of difficulty**, ensuring a fair and competitive experience. The player with more knowledge gets more points. Speed is an important factor too. Strategy is the third component (using 50:50 Joker, Using the “refuse to answer” Joker).
